3	Snail's Bank Orchard Dry	5.2%	Herefordshire	Dabinett apples bring a crisp, balanced flavour to this blend.
4	Aston Manor's Friels Vintage	5.5%	Herefordshire	Award-winning pale gold cider, medium dry and refreshingly fruity.
5	Gwynt y draig Black dragon	7.2%	Glamorgan	Strong, richly coloured and fruity with an award-winning aroma.
6	Harry's Haymaker	6.0%	Devon	Beautifully balanced with a clean, dry finish.
7	Healey's Flattler Original	5.5%	Cornwall	Slightly cloudy, light and packed with fruity, refreshing flavour.
8	Dorset Nectar's Medium Organic	5.0%	Dorset	Smooth with hints of orange; made from 11 organic apple varieties.
9	Celtic Marches' Thundering Molly	5.2%	Herefordshire	Golden and meticulously balanced with a soft finish.
10	Gwatkin's Yarlington mill	6.0%	Hereford	Award-winning single variety cider with outstanding flavour.
11	Gwynt's Happy Daze	4.5%	Wales	Light cider with a fruity aroma and a well-balanced finish.
12	Harry's Scrummage	6.0%	Somerset	Golden, medium cider with a well-balanced fruity flavour.
13	Hecks's Glastonbury Gold	6.0%	Somerset	Smooth and easy-drinking blend from apples grown near Glastonbury Tor.
14	Lilley's Fire Dancer	4.5%	Somerset	Cloudy with a rich rosy hue and intense, juicy apple flavour.
15	Lilley's Select	4.8%	Somerset	Crisp and refreshing with a bold, appley taste.
16	Sandford Orchard's Devon Red	4.5%	Devon	Refreshing and flavourful with a hint of sweetness.
17	Sanford Orchard's Devon mist	4.5%	Devon	Unfiltered session cider with a bold flavour and long finish.
18	Dorset Nectar's Sweet Maiden	4.2%	Dorset	Award-winning organic blend with natural sweetness & velvety smoothness.

27	Lilley's Passion Fruit Martini	3.4%	Somerset	A modern twist of passionfruit, vanilla and lime with Somerset cider.
28	Lilley's Peach	4.0%	Somerset	Juicy, ripe peach cider. Sweet and full of flavour.
